

Cumulative Blood Product Record (CBPR)

Update

- ✓ Place check mark in box labeled "Consent/Verification" once it has been confirmed that informed consent has been obtained and that the 2 person verification of right product to the right patient has been complete.
- ✓ Donation Number- this is the number obtained from the sticker on the back of the blood product. The sticker can be adhered to this sheet.
- ✓ Lot Number and Sequence Number- this is the number that must be recorded for all blood product derivatives i.e. HSA 25%. This sticker is rectangular and will take up 4 spaces on CBPR (old form this would take up 6 spaces).
- ✓ Vital signs- new column "oxygen therapy"
- ✓ Return ROT (Record of Transfusion)- this box has been added to prompt the transfusionist to fill out and return the ROT to the blood bank after the blood product has been initiated.
- ✓ Place a Y or N in the column "Suspected Transfusion Reaction" according to the guide at the top of the CBPR after the transfusion has been initiated.
- ✓ Interventions are intended for a short note to direct reader to the IPN or patient progress note to document further.
- ✓ Total volume infused- in this section record the total volume of product infused after the transfusion is complete. This must also be documented on the patients fluid balance record.
- ✓ 2 initials are required of the individuals who have completed the 2 person verification only.
- ✓ On discharge from a facility a patient is required to be notified that they have received a blood transfusion and what product(s) they have received during their admission. Please indicate in this section when this has been done. This can be provided to patient as either an identification card or written on patients discharge instructions.
- ✓ This document is 2 sided.
